Project Summary

Objectives

We are writing a youth exchange project under the EU Youth Program Action 1 in France which will be held on July 18th-24th 2021 in Turkey with Italy, Lebanon, Denmark and Egypt. There will be 5 participants (between 15-30) and 1 group leader who will attend from each country, a total of 30 people. They aim to raise awareness of young people about global environmental issues, promote usage of 3R (reduce-reuse-recycle), climate change, make people use eco-friendly stuffs and sustainable energy resources, develop intercultural dialogue and solidarity by developing their vision, raising awareness of people and having international knowledge and skills that try to touch the lives of other young people and cultures with them. The main theme of the project is climate change and the environmental problems. A project management team will be established through 3 basic methods which are the nonformal learning, intercultural learning and social media.

General objectives of the project;

- Create environmental awareness through the European dimension to sign on the concepts of climate change and renewable energy,
- Create awareness and mobility of young people about global environmental issues; climate change at international level,
- Strengthen the cultural dialog of the young people, by including young people from different cultural, ethnic and religious,
- Be able to suggest collective and individual solutions to protect the environment,
- Provide a space to learn the realities on the topics of the project in each country,
- Increase cooperation between organizations of countries and European Union countries.
- Sharing best practices about the themes of the project and work with young people.
- Create the space for contact making and networking as a base of future projects,

Functional objectives of the project;

- Apply the 3R (reduce, recycle and reuse) plan effectively into humans lives starting from youth groups,
- Give information through workshops and media about measures,
- Visit and give seminars in governmental and non governmental organizations
- Encourage people to make them use public transportation and bicycle rather than personal vehicles.
- make people conscious and get them accustomed to the use of environmentally friendly materials.

During the exchange, the participants will gain new skills as a result of different kind of activities with themes dedicated to global warming, climate change, suggestions and creative recycling ideas and energy savings. For quality realization of the objectives of this exchange, we will use various methods, such as: learning by doing, ice-breaking, role playing games, group discussion, energizing, team building, field tasks. The most effective way to reach the aims that we stand for – to raise the awareness in protecting the natural environment, we'll make quality set of actions: spreading the recycling idea, making boxes for animal feeding, wooden houses for births, joint actions with the local community through volunteers work to point to the need and the opportunity for self organizing. We will also organise bike tour as a contribution in promoting ecofriendly transportation ideas. We believe that this Exchange will be the stone that will ricochet across the water and make a lot of more waves.

Activities

We will carry out the following activities to increase environmental and climate change awareness with participating groups, participating leaders and young people coming from 6 different countries (for 7 days except 2 days travel). We agreed to carry out activities in Karaman, Turkey as a common decision with our partners. With 30 participants, our partnership will be realized with the partnership of Our participants are between the ages of 15-30 and are actively involved in local projects. They aim to develop intercultural dialogue and solidarity by developing their vision, raising awareness of people and having international knowledge and skills that try to touch the lives of other young people and cultures with them.

Day1 AM: Warm up Turkey, Ice Breaking, Program review, Agenda explanation + Hopes, fear and contribution, Team bulding+know each other, E+ e youthpass,

Day 1 PM: NGO presentations, Open Discussion + Pre-Personal Evaluation Skills, Sharing moment, Final analyses
-By using creative and interactive methods by KIG, Turkish night event will enable youth groups to explore Turkish culture in more depth.

Day 2 AM: Meke Lake visit; As Karaman international youth group, our group leader and young people will be responsible for the organization. While making field observations, group leaders and young people will be able to watch the lake with a drone, collecting data with photos, videos, etc., and walking around Meke lake. The walking route around the lake will be prepared using the "Actionbound" mobile app, and groups for walking will be created by KIG.

Day 2 PM: It is planned to discuss and evaluate the extent of the destruction opened by the evaluations to be made at the end of the day. Data and observations collected the next day (at the end of the trip) will be done with digital review methods (drone images, photos, videos, etc.) and end-of-day analysis with slides and reports prepared jointly by the participating groups

-Feelings theater - A theater that displays the results of climate change will be exhibited using creative drama methods to discover emotional responses led by the Karaman international youth group.

-Cultural night by Denmark

Day 3 AM: The seminar "Stop climate change" under the leadership of KIG will be held with a visual presentation to reduce negative impact and losses with local and international awareness methods.

-Presentation on sustainable and renewable energy sources will be made to reduce negative impact and losses with local and international awareness methods

-Quiz with kahoot: Participants will answer questions prepared about climate changes and precautions using kahoot quiz apps on their mobile phones or laptops

-The glossary of climate change: Each participant will be given a letter from English alphabet and will be asked for related words starting with that letter. In 1 minute the more word, the more point they will get.

Day 3 PM: Evaluation of the day, Sharing the results and experiences, Examining the data obtained by taking photos and videos

-An interactive and creative cultural night will be organized by the participants of the youth of France.

Day 4 AM: An interim evaluation of the youth change will reflect the process and the results of the previous days. Mixed groups will give feedback to each other and the causes of destruction, awareness methods and measures to be taken will be discussed with the leaders.

-Let's compose climate song!

Review of the day- Group discussion.

Day 4 PM: Cultural night by Egypt

Day 5 AM: Visit to places with sun and wind energy and "Tour of cycling", an awareness raising movement prepared using the "Actionbound" mobile application, will be held. Equipment and route will be provided and determined by KIG. After the tour with slogan T-shirts, an open-air workshop will be organized on leisure and the reduction of climate change led by the applicant group.

Day 5 PM: Cultural night by Italy

Day 6 AM: Follow-up, evaluation and dissemination planning and evaluation of change. The leaders who filled the questionnaires of the mobility tool; The "Youthpass" award ceremony and the national press invitation led by KIG, and local official invitations will be carried out.

Impact

The results we expect from our project are to instill the awareness of the climate crisis to the participating country groups with the contribution of the activities we planned. If we do not take action to repair something at the moment, we ensure that there will be an increase in the rate of climate change every day. As a result of this awareness, as young people who love their environment and nature, we want to lead a decrease in this rate even at one percent. In parallel with these results, behaviors that will become habit will occur in humans. As a result of these positive effects, recycling - prevents unnecessary tree felling - reducing unnecessary electricity use - helps increase our water resources - using aluminumfree deodorant - reducing the damage to the ozone layer - and aiming to have the consciousness to repair many such problems. The results we expect in this project are to create the awareness of our group members that we have done a lot to raise awareness and repair the climate change awareness of other participating country members, and as a result, to have good habits such as recycling, reducing electricity usage, etc. Results of the project on local level will be increase of ecological awareness, tolerance, acceptance of foreigners, inclusion and active participation in social life of Karaman people. In the long term perspective Karaman will become better place to live as a multicultural place of tolerance and respect towards nature. Exchange of good practices between partner organizations in different countries will take place.

The long term output of this project is

- the creation of an international network of young people interested in sustainable solutions of environmental problems and climate change,
- Awareness of youth across Europe about global issues,
- To instill courage to take actions about climate change with simple solutions such as using 3R(reduce-recycle-reuse) in their life,
- will be developed new ideas and strategies for better learning among 30 participants,
- 30 Youth pass certificates will have been provided for each participant,
- 30 young participants will have gained green, social entrepreneurship skills,
- 30 participants will have strengthened European citizenship skills,
- 30 participants will have shared experiences and expertise in different fields,
- 70% of participants will have improved foreign language, 100% of the participants raised the awareness for different cultures,
- Increased visibility of Erasmus + program and impact on multiple levels (local,national and international level),

The expected short term benefits are

- the exchange of best practices between partners, enabling all participants to draw inspiration for their own work at home
- the promotion of environmental activists and sustainable lifestyles among young people
- increasing youth participation in the sending organizations.

This Youth Exchange aims at allowing more young people to engage in projects for a better, bright, clean future by showing the desired impact on the target group. The project will lead to increased cooperation and exchange between the partners. It is time that the movement takes its young members seriously and this Youth Exchange is one step to spark a new development.
